The May 8, 2023, WRA Board of Directors meeting was held at the Whisper Creek Clubhouse. Thanks to those who attended. Below please find highlights of the May 2023 meeting:

2. Installation of electric service was requested by a resident. The request was taken under advisement.

3. Transparency of Board actions was discussed by a resident.

4. Four bids were received for the culvert repair on Windstone Dr. Bids to be discussed at a future meeting.

5. A bid was received for the installation of 2 flag poles for the GA and TN state flags. The Board voted not to go forward with the installation at this time.

6. An upgrade of the landscaping at the front of Windstone was approved.

7. Six new swings were installed at the playground. Repair of the drainage and installation of new mulch was completed on 5/15/23.

8. Repairs to the stone wall at the front entrance were approved.

9. The annual audit review was completed and accepted by the Board and will be available on the Members Only page of the WRA website.
