## ATTENTION WALKERS:

With the cooler temperatures come fewer daylight hours. Please exercise extreme caution when out walking and follow these safety guidelines:

1. Walk on sidewalks wherever they are available.
2. If there is no sidewalk, walk facing traffic and as far from traffic as possible.
3. Keep alert; don't be distracted by electronic devices that take your eyes (and ears) off the road.
4. Whenever possible, cross streets at crosswalks or intersections, where drivers expect pedestrians. Look for cars in all directions, including those turning left or right.
5. If a crosswalk or intersection is not available, locate a well-lit area where you have the best view of traffic. Wait for a gap in traffic that allows enough time to cross safely; continue watching for traffic as you cross.
6. Never assume a driver sees you. Make eye contact with drivers as they approach to make sure you are seen.
7. Be visible at all times. Wear bright clothing during the day, and wear reflective materials or use a flashlight at night.

## WRA Meeting Highlights for October 14, 2019

The October 2019 WRA Board of Directors meeting was held as scheduled at the Whisper Creek Clubhouse. Thanks to those who attended. Below please find highlights of the October meeting:

1. New signage directing visitors to the front gate will be installed at the rear gate. Please remind your visitors that the rear gate is for resident use only.
2. The Lonesome Dove road repairs are complete. Additional repairs to a culvert cover and speed bump repairs have also been completed.
3. The lock on the gate at the front RV lot was replaced due to age. The new lock was keyed to match existing keys.
4. All visitors to WindStone on Halloween entering between 5 p.m. and 9 p.m. must have a Halloween guest tag. Information regarding requesting these tags is available at the WindStone website, was announced in the October Newsletter, and posted on the electronic sign. An e-mail was also sent to residents with this information.
5. Two additional guards have been hired to help direct traffic flow on Halloween evening. Please drive very carefully, as trick-or-treaters will be plentiful, and remember that parking is not permitted on Windstone Drive.
6. Judging for the Halloween Decorating Contest will occur on Sunday, October 27. Residents need only to decorate their home to participate in the event.
7. Several residents have voiced concerns over the sewage charges on their water bills. The sewer system is privately owned by Rainbro, Inc., and is not the property of the WindStone Residential Association. Mr. Dave Hammel, owner of the system, will present information and answer questions about the system at the December 2019 WRA meeting. Residents can also contact the Catoosa Utility District Authority with questions about their statements.
8. Plans for repair of the Lake Wisley spillway are being completed. The fountain has been temporarily turned off due to low water levels in the lake. This will prevent the fountain motor from becoming clogged with debris, and will help avoid costly future repairs.
